


Investigative Journalism Grant

A grant program which aims to strengthen the field of investigative journalism by providing newsrooms with necessary resources:

- Finances
- Knowledge and Skills
- Network
- 5 year pilot program
- Focus on local investigative journalism
- Annually aprox. € 3 million








Pilot grant program Local Broadasters
